

The Summative Reflection: Reflecting on the Graduation Portfolio

The **summative reflection**, the final reflection of the portfolio, is your opportunity to look at your portfolio as a whole and assess your growth as a high school student. This self assessment requires you to explain how you have demonstrated proficiency and why you are ready to graduate.

To prepare to write the summative reflection, read through the learning reflections for the work you have chosen for your graduation portfolio. This will help you to develop a sense of how you have grown as a learner and how you have met your goals.

Remember you must reach proficiency on this assignment, as defined by the rubric, to complete your graduation portfolio.
