In this project, my mentor will be teaching me the skills of learning how to wrap a vehicle. The way you “wrap” a car is after you buy vinyl material, you wipe down the car and make sure the surface is flat and doesn't have any dust or rubbish on the OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) paint. You then align the wrapping material to best fit the panel you are currently working on. You take off the back paper, and stick the vinyl to the car. After aligned, and somewhat applied, you use a scraper tool to fix all the bubbles out of the material. Once that's done, you move on to the next section
