

Instructions for Obtaining Approval for Senior Project

You must obtain approval of your chosen project topic, product, and mentor before beginning work on your Senior Project. To do this you will submit a *Senior Project Proposal* to the Senior Project Review Board. This proposal must state clearly how you intend to meet the requirements of the Senior Project. Submit your proposal to the Review Board by the date indicated on the Senior Project calendar along with your *Mentor Agreement Letter* and the completed "Acknowledgement and Consent Forms" packet, which includes the *Narragansett High School Senior Project Ethical Statement*, *Senior Project Proposal Parent/Guardian Consent Form*, *Student Acknowledgement Form and Liability Waiver*, and *Parent Acknowledgement Form and Liability Waiver*. In addition, your mentor must undergo a state criminal background check and be added to the Narragansett School Department's list of approved volunteers.

You will submit an electronic copy of your proposal to your teacher. You will receive feedback from the board identifying changes that are necessary for approval. Once your proposal is approved, you may begin your project.

Keep in mind that this is a graduation requirement. To be successful, you must reach proficiency on all components of the Senior Project. Fulfilling the requirements with integrity and honesty is mandatory. Evidence of cheating on any part of the Senior Project may require the completion of an entirely new topic/project and may result in your not graduating with your class.
